Helmut Klausner

"You're no longer there, where you were - but you're everywhere we are."

The French writer Victor Hugo said these words, and they depict very precisely my feelings when I think of Helmut. And I think very often of my fatherly friend. So I called secretly my friend from Sonneberg. Officially, I would have not ventured this out because of my respect for his personality.

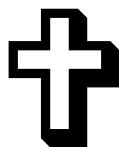
Yes, Helmut Klausner was a personality! Due to his authority and his character, Helmut was even a very special personality. During many years of our mutual correspondence, I could convince myself of his expertise in various fields over and over again. No matter what issues I broached, Helmut always knew some interesting facts and had his opinion about them. His electronic correspondence (because of his illness, Helmut only wrote e-mails in recent years) was always marked by friendliness, helpfulness and responsiveness. Even if we had not the same opinion on a particular matter - my friend from Sonneberg was never preachy, but tried to convince me by arguments or drew attention to this or that circumstance. Besides chess, of course, the family was the main component of our correspondence. In many emails, Helmut spoke proudly about his family and of course, especially about his grandson. So I could experience Tim's growing up at first hand.

Helmut's view was seldom backward-looking. This was particularly notable in his interest in the contemporary history. How is the human race? Where the European Union is heading? How should politics be reasonable? These were questions whose answers Helmut was interested in.

Helmut Klausner wrote more than 40 articles for the CiF Magazine! Sometimes I even received two articles for the same issue. "So that you would have something in stock," as he used to say caringly. In his texts, Helmut treated all areas of chess, correspondence chess and our correspondence chess club. Especially, "Chess in Friendship" and its continued existence were of his big concern, and he did not avoid any friendly confrontation. Of course, Helmut watched with a big concern a decline in the traditional postal correspondence chess. But he adapted himself to the changes and played games by e-mail as well as on the chess server.

Since 16 March, the editors of the CiF Magazine have been mourning. A voice that was so familiar and provided a security to us fell silent forever. One says that time heals all wounds. I do not think so, but time teaches us to live with the incomprehensible.
