Meeting of the CiF Executive Committee in Heilbad Heiligenstadt

The regular yearly meeting of the CiF Executive Committee took place on 7th October, 2016 in the Norddeutscher Bund Hotel in Heilbad Heiligenstadt

Thomas Amelang, Matthias Jurisch, Roland Markus, Wolfgang Mehlhorn and Josef Mrkvicka attended the meeting.

Josef Mrkvicka was in the chair of the meeting.

Wolfgang Mehlhorn took minutes of the meeting.

The meeting followed the following programme:

1. Opening
2. Review of tasks recorded in the last minutes.
3. Financial issues“(Dues 2015-2016, Audit of the CiF Accounting)
4. CiF News (including the next issue)
5. CiF postal tournaments
6. CiF email and CiF server tournaments
7. CiF Meeting 2016 and following Meetings
8. Elections to the CiF Executive Committee 2019
9. All other business
10. Preparation of the next EC meeting

Point 1

Josef Mrkvicka welcomes the participants and pronounces that all EC members are present. The proposed programme of the EC meeting was accepted.

Point 2

Still open tasks have been spotted under following points of the minutes of the EC meeting of 2nd October 2015:

Point 2:

The newest Tournament Rules have been posted on our website under Rules.

Point 3: the task has been fulfilled by Matthias Jurisch.

Point 4: CiF software

A creation of the software will not be kept in eye any longer, as the maker probably stopped any work on this project. Thomas Amelang should require the refund of the just paid advance payment.

Point 5: CiF News

Thomas Amelang should have addressed Gisela Henker because of the co-operation at editing of the CiF News, this did not happen as the CiF News will be edited by Thomas Amelang however the publishing of the CiF News is becoming very difficult because of his personal overload of work.

Point 3

Thomas Amelang reports that the financial cash credit has remained almost constant since 2013. For 6 years no invoices have been submitted by Remotechess. However there are no growing financial risks as the older services have already been time-barred. CiF has enough reserves available.

Thomas Amelang presented the final Financial Statements for the business year 2015 to Alfred Stummerer to be audited. The audit of the CiF accounting has been finished with a positive result, without reservations.

Josef Mrkvicka will address the memberied #1585 Norman Garland because of payment of dues by Australian CiF members.

The member #2015 Mike Bertram (USA) should pay by PayPal.

On the CiF Homepage a notification for the Remote players should be posted regarding the yearly due 15,- €.

Josef Mrkvicka takes over Spain and Portugal as their new Section Leader and will take care of their payments of dues. This section has been leaded by Jaime Armengol who withdrew from CiF.

Point 4

Josef Mrkvicka asks, when the next CiF News could be published. Thomas Amelang advises that this could happen in November, but the only available article so far is the announcement of the match against CCI.

Roland Markus tells that he has submitted an article to Thomas. It was decided that the form of the News would be considered as second-rate, in this way it will be possible to produce the CiF News with less effort. However it should be published as regularly as possible.

Point 5

Matthias Jurisch reports that the number of postal tournaments becomes smaller all the time. Despite this development they should continue.

A match against CCI should be announced.

As a new type of tournaments no-engine tournaments have been introduced.

A postal tournament should be announced by CiF and also the CCI members should be invited. They needn't become CiF members, but of course they won't get any other rights by CiF.

Point 6

Roland Markus reports that there are 147 registered CiF members by Remote. Out of them circa 60 are active.

The contact with the administrators of the website has been completely stopped.

Roland Markus will produce a list of the Remote players and submit it to Thomas Amelang.

There are almost no participants at email tournaments. Provided that there are entries, they should be continued.

Point 7

There are 26 persons participating in the meeting in Heilbad Heiligenstadt, this should be assessed positively.

The meeting 2017 should take place from 30th September till 3rd October 2017.

As per the year 2018 Rolf Sicker would be ready to organize this meeting. Possibly it could take place in Passau. However there is no decision yet about the venue.

Point 8

A decision about the election rules has been postponed.

Point 9

Josef Mrkvicka lost the contact with #0923 Erwin Liebert and #1090 Merike Rytowa. He proposes their expulsion from CiF which was unanimously accepted.

The members who play on Remote and have not yet paid the dues for the year 2016, will be provisionally suspended.

By some members who fell into longer arrears will be expelled from CiF.

Point 10

The next EC meeting will take place within the CiF meeting in Dresden.
